- Since competition law came into existence in the US, the economic theories of competition have exercised a strong influence upon it.
- On the contrary, at the early stages of EU competition law, economics had a negligible impact on European competition law, as EU competition rules and their application were largely driven by the goal of achieving market integration.
- However, in mid-90s the EU competition law has been <u>revised</u> and the old-fashioned formalistic legal approach has been replaced by a "*More Economic Approach*" (EU Commission definition).
